

For 2024 DSA-Sec Exercise

- For submission of additional documents (scanned documents, images &/or videos):
 - Label the document/image/video with “Full Name of Student_Primary School_Talent Area Abbreviation-X”, where X is the number of document/image/video submitted e.g. SitiRaihana_Earth Pri Sch_EL-1 OR ChloeLimSiEn_Water Pri Sch_MEP-2.
 - If possible, paste these documents/images into a single document/file, saving it with a meaningful name and then submit it via the link of the relevant talent area. Ensure that anyone whom they are sent to, can OPEN & VIEW them.
- For submissions of large file size e.g. videos or images, save them in a specially created FOLDER in your own Google Drive or Dropbox etc
 - Copy the link and ensure that anyone given this link can OPEN & VIEW the documents and submit your link to the relevant talent area.
- The talent area links are found under the column “Link of e-Form For Submission of Additional Documents” in the table below.
- Shortlisted applicants will be notified of the date and time of their in-person selection trials/auditions/interviews via email.
- **Please note that meeting all criteria does not guarantee the applicant will be shortlisted for selection trials/auditions/interviews or given an offer.**
